Rider Registration Opens for the Jefferson Chamber's 8th Annual Tour De Jefferson

METAIRIE, **LA** – Registration has opened for the 8th Annual Tour de Jefferson, a bike ride designed to bring people to the beautiful state and national parks of the West Bank of Jefferson Parish. Tour de Jefferson has become one of the premier cycling events in the region. Organizers are preparing for more than 700 participants to arrive Sunday, November 2 at Bayou Segnette State Park.

There will be scenic rest stops along the way equipped with plenty of energizing snacks and drinks. The ride will finish at the Bayou Segnette State Park, where riders will enjoy good food, beverages and music at the Fin du Tour after party.
