His recent book with Republican counterpart and wife, Mary Matalin, *Love and War: Twenty Years, Three Presidents, Two Daughters and One Louisiana Home* was released in 2014. He also serves as a Professor of Practice at Tulane University in New Orleans, where he now resides.
